## The True Prophet Typified by Moses

## Monday 4/6

**Amos 3:7**

7 Surely the Lord Jehovah will not do anything unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

**2 Peter 1:20-21**

20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of one's own interpretation;

21 For no prophecy was ever borne by the will of man, but men spoke from God while being borne by the Holy Spirit.

**1 Cor.14:24-26, 31**

24 But if all prophesy and some unbeliever or unlearned person enters, he is convicted by all, he is examined by all;

25 The secrets of his heart become manifest; and so falling on his face, he will worship God, declaring that indeed God is among you.

26 What then, brothers? Whenever you come together, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

31 For you can all prophesy one by one that all may learn and all may be encouraged.

**2 Tim. 3:16-17**

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and profitable for teaching, for conviction, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

17 That the man of God may be complete, fully equipped for every good work.

**Heb. 4:12**

12 For the word of God is living and operative and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit and of joints and marrow, and able to discern the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

15 A Prophet will Jehovah your God raise up for you from your midst, from among your brothers, like me; you shall listen to Him.

18 A Prophet will I raise up for them from the midst of their brothers like you; and I will put My words in His mouth, and He will speak to them all that I command Him.

**John 7:16**

16 Jesus therefore answered them and said, My teaching is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

**John 12:49-50**

49 For I have not spoken from Myself; but the Father who sent Me, He Himself has given Me commandment, what to say and what to speak.

50 And I know that His commandment is eternal life. The things therefore that I speak, even as the Father has said to Me, so I speak.

**Deut.10:12-13**

12 And now, O Israel, what does Jehovah your God ask of you except that you fear Jehovah your God so that you would walk in all His ways and love Him and serve Jehovah your God with all your heart and with all your soul;

13 So that you would keep the commandments of Jehovah and His statutes, which I am commanding you today, for your good.

**John 8:28**

28 Jesus therefore said to them, When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am, and that I do nothing from Myself, but as My Father has taught Me, I speak these things.

**Rev. 19:13**

13 And He is clothed with a garment dipped in blood; and His name is called the Word of God.

**Heb. 1:2**

2 Has at the last of these days spoken to us in the Son, whom He appointed Heir of all things, through whom also He made the universe;

**John 14:10-11**

10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak from Myself, but the Father who abides in Me does His works.

11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; but if not, believe because of the works themselves.

**Matt.11:27**

27 All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one fully knows the Son except the Father; neither does anyone fully know the Father except the Son and him to whom the Son wills to reveal Him.

**John 1:1, 4-5**

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

**1 Cor. 7:12, 25**

12 But to the rest I say, I, not the Lord, If any brother has an unbelieving wife and she consents to dwell with him, he must not leave her;

25 Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord, but I give my opinion

as one who has been shown mercy by the Lord to be faithful.

**Matt. 10:27**

27 What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, proclaim on the housetops.

**John 14:20, 23**

20 In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

23 Jesus answered and said to him, If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make an abode with him.

**Gal. 2:20**

20 I am crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

**Eph. 6:19-20**

19 And for me, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known in boldness the mystery of the gospel,

20 For which I am an ambassador in a chain, that in it I would speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

**Phil. 2:21**

21 For all seek their own things, not the things of Christ Jesus.

**Friday 4/10**

**1 Cor. 7:40**

40 But she is more blessed if she so remains, according to my opinion; but I think that I also have the Spirit of God.

**1 Cor. 6:17**

17 But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit.

**John 15:4-5, 7-12**

4 Abide in Me and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me.

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. He who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.

7 If you abide in Me and My words abide in you,

ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you.

8 In this is My Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and so you will become My disciples.

9 As the Father has loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

11 These things I have spoken to you that My joy may be in you and that your joy may be made full.

12 This is My commandment, that you love one another even as I have loved you.

**Saturday 4/11**

**1 Cor. 7:10**

10 But to the married I charge, not I but the Lord, A wife must not be separated from her husband

**1 Cor. 2:9-16**

9 But as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard and which have not come up in man's heart; things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

10 But to us God has revealed them through the Spirit, for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

11 For who among men knows the things of man, except the spirit of man which is in him? In the same way, the things of God also no one has known except the Spirit of God.

12 But we have received not the spirit of the world but the Spirit which is from God, that we may know the things which have been graciously given to us by God;

13 Which things also we speak, not in words taught by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual things with spiritual words.

14 But a soulish man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him and he is not able to know them because they are discerned spiritually.

15 But the spiritual man discerns all things, but he himself is discerned by no one.

16 For who has known the mind of the Lord and will instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

**1 Cor. 6:19**

19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

**2 Sam. 23:2**

2 The Spirit of Jehovah spoke through me, And His word was on my tongue.

**Jer. 1:4-12**

4 Now the word of Jehovah came to me, saying:  
5 Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you; And before you came forth from the womb, I sanctified you. I have appointed you as a prophet to the nations.

6 Then I said, Alas, Lord Jehovah! Indeed, I do not know how to speak, For I am a youth.

7 But Jehovah said to me, Do not say, I am a youth; For everywhere I send you, you shall go; And everything I command you, you shall speak.

8 Do not be afraid of their faces, For I am with you to deliver you, declares Jehovah.

9 Then Jehovah stretched out His hand and touched my mouth; and Jehovah said to me, Now I have put My words in your mouth.

10 See, I have appointed you this day Over the nations and over the kingdoms To pluck up and to break down, To destroy and to tear down, To build up and to plant.

11 Then the word of Jehovah came to me, saying, What do you see, Jeremiah? And I said, I see a branch of an almond tree.

12 And Jehovah said to me, You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it.

**Ezek. 1:3**

3 The word of Jehovah came expressly to Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar; and the hand of Jehovah was upon him there.
