Eccl. 1:2, 9, 14

2 Vanity of vanities, says the Preacher; Vanity of vanities; all is vanity.

9 What has been is what will be, And what has been done is what will be done, And there is nothing new under the sun.

14 I have seen all the works that are done under the sun, and indeed, all is vanity and a chasing after wind.

Eccl. 2:22

22 For what will a man have with all his labor and with the striving of his heart by which he labors under the sun?

Col. 3:1-3

1 If therefore you were raised together with Christ, seek the things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.

2 Set your mind on the things which are above, not on the things which are on the earth.

3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

2 Cor. 5:17

17 So then if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old things have passed away; behold, they have become new.

Gal. 6:15

15 For neither is circumcision anything nor uncircumcision, but a new creation is what matters.

Matt. 11:28-29

28 Come to Me all who toil and are burdened, and I will give you rest.

29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am meek and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

2 Cor. 4:18

18 Because we do not regard the things which are seen but the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Zech. 12:1

1 The burden of the word of Jehovah concerning Israel. Thus declares Jehovah, who stretches forth the heavens and lays the foundations of the earth and forms the spirit of man within him,

Job 32:8

8 But there is a spirit in man, And the breath of the Almighty gives them understanding.

1 Cor. 2:9-12

9 But as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard and which have not come up in man's heart; things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

10 But to us God has revealed them through the Spirit, for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

11 For who among men knows the things of man, except the spirit of man which is in him? In the same way, the things of God also no one has known except the Spirit of God.

12 But we have received not the spirit of the world but the Spirit which is from God, that we may know the things which have been graciously given to us by God;

Eccl. 12:13-14

13 The end of the matter, when all has been heard, is this: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the whole of man.

14 For God will bring every deed to judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

20 But you did not so learn Christ,

21 If indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him as the reality is in Jesus,

18 Being darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance which is in them, because of the hardness of their heart;

19 Who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lasciviousness to work all uncleanness in greediness.

1 Pet. 2:21

21 For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered on your behalf, leaving you a model so that you may follow in His steps;

John 13:15

15 For I have given you an example so that you also may do even as I have done to you.

John 1:14, 17

14 And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality.

17 For the law was given through Moses; grace and reality came through Jesus Christ.

Rom. 8:28-29

28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

29 Because those whom He foreknew, He also predestinated to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the Firstborn among many brothers;

Eph. 4:24

1 John 5:20

20 And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding that we might know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in

His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.

1 John 1:5-7

5 And this is the message which we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and are not practicing the truth;

7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from every sin.

3 John 1:3-4

3 For I rejoiced greatly at the brothers' coming and testifying to your steadfastness in the truth, even as you walk in truth.

4 I have no greater joy than these things, that I hear that my children are walking in the truth.

John 4:23-24

23 But an hour is coming, and it is now, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truthfulness, for the Father also seeks such to worship Him.

24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

Rom. 8:19-21, 1-2, 4, 6

19 For the anxious watching of the creation eagerly awaits the revelation of the sons of God.

20 For the creation was made subject to vanity, not of its own will, but because of Him who subjected it,

21 In hope that the creation itself will also be freed from the slavery of corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

1 There is now then no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus.

2 For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death.

4 That the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the spirit.

6 For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

Col. 3:4

4 When Christ our life is manifested, then you also

will be manifested with Him in glory.

Phil. 3:21

21 Who will transfigure the body of our humiliation to be conformed to the body of His glory, according to His operation by which He is able even to subject all things to Himself.

1 John 3:1-2

1 Behold what manner of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and we are. Because of this the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not yet been manifested what we will be. We know that if He is manifested, we will be like Him because we will see Him even as He is.

Rom. 8:22-23

Matt. 6:10, 13

10 Your kingdom come; Your will be done, as in heaven, so also on earth.

12 Saying, "I will declare Your name to My brothers; in the midst of the church I will sing hymns of praise to You."

Rev. 5:10-13

10 And have made them a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign on the earth.

11 And I saw, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and of the living creatures and of the elders, and their number was ten thousands of ten thousands and thousands of thousands,

1 And he showed me a river of water of life, bright as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb in the middle of its street.

5 And night will be no more; and they have no need of the light of a lamp and of the light of the sun, for the Lord God will shine upon them; and they will reign forever and ever.

Matt. 13:43

43 Then the righteous will shine forth like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear.
