## **Message Five—Study Questions**

- 1. What does it mean to "learn Christ...as the reality is in Jesus" (Eph. 4:20-21)? How does our experience of "the reality...in Jesus" issue in the reality of the Body of Christ? How do we practically "learn Christ...as the reality is in Jesus" so that we automatically live Him according to the mold, the form, the pattern, described in the Gospels so that His biography becomes our history?
- 2. What does it mean to experience Christ in His experiences as the burnt offering? Have you experienced Christ in His experiences as the burnt offering, specifically in His being "slaughtered" or "skinned" or "cut into pieces"? In relation to the burnt offering, what do the ashes signify, and how do the ashes eventually become the New Jerusalem?
- 3. Using verses from the Gospel of John, show how the Lord's life was His work, His move, and His ministry, and how as a man of prayer He was one with God and One in whom Satan, the ruler of the world, had nothing. Have you learned Christ as the reality is in Jesus in these aspects?
- 4. How does Christ's living as the reality of the burnt offering issue in our living a life of love in this world and being the same as He is?
