**Monday 7/15**

**1 Cor. 15:10**

**10** But by the grace of God I am what I am; and His grace unto me did not turn out to be in vain, but, on the contrary, I labored more abundantly than all of them, yet not I but the grace of God which is with me.

**2 Cor. 6:1**

**1** And working together with Him, we also entreat you not to receive the grace of God in vain;

**2 Cor. 13:14**

**14** The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

**2 Cor. 1:12**

**12** For our boasting is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in singleness and sincerity of God, not in fleshly wisdom but in the grace of God, we have conducted ourselves in the world, and more abundantly toward you.

**2 Cor. 4:15**

**15** For all things are for your sakes that the grace which has abounded through the greater number may cause the thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God.

**2 Cor. 8:1, 9**

**1** Furthermore we make known to you, brothers, the grace of God which has been given in the churches of Macedonia,

**9** For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, for your sakes He became poor in order that you, because of His poverty, might become rich.

**2 Cor. 9:8, 14**

**8** And God is able to make all grace abound unto you, that, in everything always having all sufficiency, you may abound unto every good work;

**14** While in petition on your behalf they also long after you on account of the surpassing grace of God upon you.

**2 Cor. 12:9**

**9** And He has said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is perfected in weakness. Most gladly therefore I will rather boast in my weaknesses that the

power of Christ might tabernacle over me.

**Tuesday 7/16**

**Col. 1:12**

**12** Giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you for a share of the allotted portion of the saints in the light;

**Col. 2:6-7**

**6** As therefore you have received the Christ, Jesus the Lord, walk in Him,

**7** Having been rooted and being built up in Him, and being established in the faith even as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

**Heb. 10:5-10**

**5** Therefore, coming into the world, He says, "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me.

**6** In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You did not delight.

**7** Then I said, Behold, I have come (in the roll of the book it is written concerning Me) to do Your will, O God."

**8** Saying above, "Sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You did not desire nor delight in" (which are offered according to the law),

**9** He then has said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will." He takes away the first that He may establish the second,

**10** By which will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

**1 Cor. 1:9**

**9** God is faithful, through whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

**Wednesday 7/17**

**Phil. 3:13-14**

**13** Brothers, I do not account of myself to have laid hold; but one thing I do: Forgetting the things which are behind and stretching forward to the things which are before,

**14** I pursue toward the goal for the prize to which God in Christ Jesus has called me upward.

**2 Cor. 2:10**

**10** But whom you forgive anything, I also forgive; for also what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, it

is for your sake in the person of Christ;

**Matt. 14:22-23**

**22** And immediately He compelled the disciples to step into the boat and to go before Him to the other side, while He sent the crowds away.

**23** And after He sent the crowds away, He went up to the mountain privately to pray. And when night fell, He was there alone.

**Matt. 6:6**

**6** But you, when you pray, enter into your private room, and shut your door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will repay you.

**Exo. 33:11**

**11** And Jehovah would speak to Moses face to face, just as a man speaks to his companion. And Moses would return to the camp, but his attendant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, would not depart out of the tent.

**Psa. 119:147-148**

**147** I anticipated the dawn and cried out; I hoped in Your words.

**148** My eyes anticipated the night watches, That I might muse upon Your word.

**Thursday 7/18**

**Col. 3:16**

**16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to God.

**1 Cor. 14:26**

**26** What then, brothers? Whenever you come together, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

**Deut. 12:1, 8**

**1** These are the statutes and the judgments that you shall be certain to do in the land which Jehovah, the God of your fathers, has given you to possess, all the days that you live on the earth.

**8** You shall not do according to all that we do here today, each man doing all that is right in his own eyes;

**Deut. 14:22-23**

**22** You must give a tenth of all the produce of your seed, which the field brings forth, year by year.

**23** And you shall eat before Jehovah your God, in the place where He will choose to cause His name to dwell, the tithe of your grain, of your new wine, and of your fresh oil and the firstborn of your herd and flock, that you may learn to fear Jehovah your God always.

**Col. 3:17**

**17** And whatever you do in word or in deed, do all things in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

**1 Cor. 14:12, 15, 31**

**12** So also you, since you are zealous of spirits, seek that you may excel for the building up of the church.

**15** What then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray also with the mind; I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing also with the mind.

**31** For you can all prophesy one by one that all may learn and all may be encouraged.

**Friday 7/19**

**Deut. 12:5-7, 11, 13-14, 18**

**5** But to the place which Jehovah your God will choose out of all your tribes to put His name, to His habitation, shall you seek, and there shall you go.

**6** And there you shall bring your burnt offerings and your sacrifices and your tithes and the heave offering of your hand and your vows and your freewill offerings and the firstborn of your herd and of your flock;

**7** And there you shall eat before Jehovah your God, and you and your households shall rejoice in all your undertakings, in which Jehovah your God has blessed you.

**11** Then to the place where Jehovah your God will choose to cause His name to dwell, there you shall bring all that I am commanding you, your burnt offerings and your sacrifices, your tithes and the heave offering of your hand and all your choice vows which you vow to Jehovah.

**13** Be careful that you do not offer up your burnt offerings in every place that you see;

**14** But in the place which Jehovah will choose in one of your tribes, there you shall offer up your burnt offerings, and there you shall do all that I am commanding you.

**18** But you shall eat them before Jehovah your God in the place which Jehovah your God will choose, you and your son and daughter, and your male servant and female servant, and the Levite who is within your gates; and you shall rejoice before Jehovah your God in all your undertakings.

**Deut. 16:16**

**16** Three times a year all your males shall appear before Jehovah your God in the place which He will choose: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles. And they shall not appear before Jehovah empty-handed;

**John 4:24**

**24** God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

**Eph. 2:21-22**

**21** In whom all the building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord;

**22** In whom you also are being built together into a dwelling place of God in spirit.

**Eph. 1:22-23**

**22** And He subjected all things under His feet and gave Him to be Head over all things to the church,

**23** Which is His Body, the fullness of the One who fills all in all.

**Psa. 26:8**

**8** O Jehovah, I love the habitation of Your house, And the place where Your glory abides.

**Psa. 29:9**

**9** The voice of Jehovah causes the hinds to calve And strips the forests bare; And in His temple all say, Glory!

**Psa. 27:4-6**

**4** One thing I have asked from Jehovah; That do I seek: To dwell in the house of Jehovah All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of Jehovah, And to inquire in His temple.

**5** For He will conceal me in His shelter In the day of trouble; He will hide me in the hiding place of His tent; He will raise me up upon a rock.

**6** And now my head is lifted up Above my enemies who surround me. And I will offer in His tent Sacrifices of shouts of joy: I will sing and psalm to Jehovah.

**Psa. 36:8-9**

**8** They are saturated with the fatness of Your house, And You cause them to drink of the river of Your pleasures.

**9** For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

**Gen. 2:10-15**

**10** And a river went forth from Eden to water the garden, and from there it divided and became four

branches.

**11** The name of the first is Pishon; it is the one that goes around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold.

**12** And the gold of that land is good; bdellium and onyx stone are there.

**13** And the name of the second river is Gihon; it is the one that goes around the whole land of Cush.

**14** And the name of the third river is Hiddekel; it is the one that goes east of Assyria. And the fourth river is the Euphrates.

**15** And Jehovah God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and to keep it.
